

## Application Instructions

### *Mylash products can be worn above or below your natural lashes....*

*Mylash products have been carefully made by hand using the lightest, softest synthetic fiber and pure cotton base materials. A fine base line enables you to wear Mylash beneath your natural lashes with easy application in complete comfort that defies detection; because the base line is hidden, there is no need for additional eye make up, unless you choose to wear it... The base line is so fine you can wear more than one pair at a time for truly beautiful effects.*

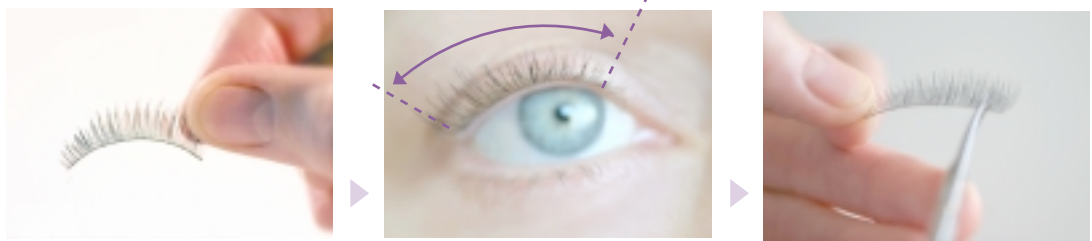
### *To apply Mylash underneath your natural lash base...*

*Before applying Mylash read these instructions carefully, follow the placement steps several times without adhesive to get coordinated. Proper application depends on patience and practice. The motion of application is not unlike applying mascara...*

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#### **Step#1 Fitting Mylash**

- There is a right and left lash. The shortest end fits towards your nose, and the longest towards the outside corners.
- Mylash should be worn shorter in width if wearing underneath your natural lashes. Starting from the beginning of the iris, and ending slightly before your natural lash base.
- Simply snip Mylash at either end to fit if necessary.



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#### **Step #2 to Apply Adhesive**

- Mylash should fit the contour of your eye; this is done by fanning the lash into a curved shape.
- Hold Mylash at the longest end with your thumb on top of curl and the base line facing you, keeping the base line visible.
- Apply a thin line of adhesive with the flat end of a toothpick, or applicator tip along the top of the base line of the lashes, allow adhesive to set for 60 seconds before applying.



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### **Step #3 to Apply Mylash Underneath**

- We suggest you sit comfortably, steady yourself by placing your elbows on the table, and angle the magnifying side of your mirror so you are looking down into it.
- With one hand place your middle finger under your brow and gently lift your eyelid to make your natural lash base visible.
- With the opposite hand hold Mylash at the longest end with your thumb on top of the curl as you would a mascara brush. Place the base line of the lash onto the base of your natural lashes, aim between the iris and outside corner. You can use your ring finger or pinky to help position the lash.
- Keep eyelid raised, with an applicator gently pat along the base to secure.



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### **Step #4 to Remove Mylash**

- Look straight into the mirror and grasp Mylash at the longest outside ends and gently peel downward.
- If Mylash does not remove easily, take a warm washcloth and place over closed eyes to loosen adhesive, repeat step #4.



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### **Step #5 to Clean & store Mylash**

- Mylash can be cleaned by mixing equal parts alcohol and water in a small dish or bottle. Drop lashes into solution and allow to soak for about five minutes.
- Take Mylash out of solution and firmly hold at the loose lash fiber ends, and peel away any adhesive from the base line.
- Hold Mylashes at the loose fiber ends and peel away the loosened adhesive.
- Place Mylashes onto a tissue and blot dry.
- Fan Mylash back into curved shape, they are now ready for adhesive application and wear.
